There is a theory held by some criminologists that evil eventually melts out of the body. That if you warehouse a man in jail long enough, <u>he</u><sup>1</sup> will become harmless. Youth's passions dim. Perversion's fires cool. It is this theory that Lawrence Singleton contested last week.

Last Wednesday a painter saw a struggle while working on a house in Tampa's suburb. Inside, a naked man appeared to be trying to kill a naked woman. The witness called the 911 emergency number, and when a police officer arrived at the door, <u>he</u><sup>2</sup> was met by an apparition. Lawrence Singleton "came out of the house staggering. <u>His</u><sup>3</sup> shirt was unbuttoned, and <u>he</u><sup>4</sup> had blood all over <u>his</u><sup>5</sup> chest." Apparently drunk, <u>he</u><sup>6</sup> announced that <u>he</u><sup>7</sup> had cut himself chopping vegetables.

But when <u>he</u><sup>8</sup> moved casually to answer a ringing phone, the officer saw a bloodied naked corpse on <u>his</u><sup>9</sup> living-room floor. After <u>his</u><sup>10</sup> arrest, Singleton, 69, declared to reporters, "They framed <u>me</u><sup>11</sup> the first time. But this time I did it."

In fact, Singleton is notorious for "the first time." In 1978 a 15-year-old runaway named Mary Vincent got a ride outside San Francisco with a man in a van. The man approached <u>her</u><sup>12</sup> sexually, moved away, but later - having liquored up - beat <u>her</u><sup>13</sup>, bound <u>her</u><sup>14</sup> and raped <u>her</u><sup>15</sup> twice. <u>He</u><sup>16</sup> chopped off <u>her</u><sup>17</sup> arms and left <u>her</u><sup>18</sup> in a concrete culvert to die. <u>She</u><sup>19</sup> didn't. The next day, Vincent was found "wandering nude ... holding up <u>her</u><sup>20</sup> arms so that the muscles and blood would not fall out." When Singleton, a merchant mariner, was sentenced for the crime, the judge said he<sup>21</sup> wished he<sup>22</sup> could "send him<sup>23</sup> to prison for the rest of his<sup>24</sup> natural life."
